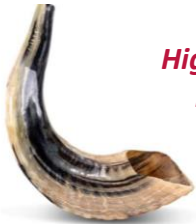

High Holiday Registration for in-person attendance at The Shul is now closed.

REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED -- Due to the unusual circumstances of the Pandemic, we have to know in advance who and how many are attending services. Space is limited. **If you plan to attend Services, you must have registered. Without registration, we do not know you are coming and are unable to offer seating.**

LOCATION OF SERVICES -- For Services and Classes, when necessary, we are forming four groups when necessary, each with maximum of 50 participants or 50% capacity whichever is fewer, with social distancing. The four locations are (1) the Sanctuary (2) Combined Social Halls (3) Outdoor Tent #1 (4) Outdoor Tent #2. Tents will be lighted, heated and/or cooled as needed and each participant will have a chair and table.

SHOFAR -- Shofar is blown this year only on Second Day of Rosh Hashana, Sunday Sept 20 because we do not blow Shofar on Shabbos. Shofar will be available for the public on Sunday, Sept 20 Second Day of Rosh Hashana at the Ort Backyard at 4:00 pm and at Aish at 2:00 pm and at 4:00 pm. Weather permitting, these will be outdoors.

MACHZORIM LOAN -- Machzorim/ Prayer Books will be available for you if you do not bring your own. If you would like to borrow a set of Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur Machzorim (High Holiday Prayer Books) for your use at home, we have about 75 sets available for loan.
