#### **RULES**

- Minors under the age of 18 require adult supervision unless otherwise noted.

- Attend with another adult if you suffer from seizures, heart or circulatory problems.
- Do not use the Mikvah if you have a communicable disease that can be transmitted by water or have been ill in the last two weeks.
- Do not use the Mikvah when under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- No running or horseplay in the Mikvah facility.
- No food or drink allowed in the Mikvah facility.
- Labeled personal items may be left in cabinets for recurring weekly use.
- Towels are provided, please do not bring personal towels, Respect the use of towels, do not dab blood, and do not use to wipe dirt off surfaces.
