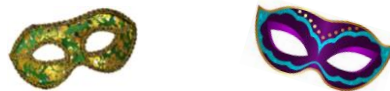
20-Feb – THIS SHABBOS – Special Pre-Purim Torah Reading: Parshas Zachor. The Torah obligates men and women to listen to the passage about Amalek. It is therefore very important to be in shul to hear the Torah reading. The Torah will be read at approximately 10:00 am and then again at 11:00 am. In addition, Parshas Zachor will be read at the Southeast Denver Community Kollel at 11:45 am for women only.
