FAST OF YOM KIPPUR

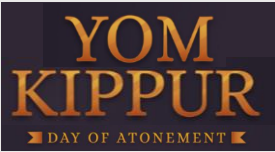
Yom Kippur Begins on Tuesday, Oct 4, with Kol Nidrei at 6:00 pm.
