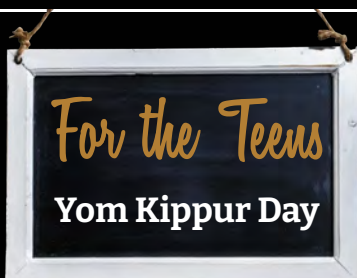
## Adult & Teen Classes
